Notes to Drill Conductor:

1-In the printed drill your words are in RED.

2-It is highly recommend to utilize a sheet of paper folded in half to slide down the page to keep your place, but more importantly, a surface to indicate tally marks as you call on the drill students to help you know how often you have called on a particular student.

3-Another consideration is to hole punch some pages on the left, some on the right side so that your drill sections are open across a 1/2-inch loose leaf binder for each of the 5 different ones.

We have 4 different types of drills:

QUOTATION DRILL COMPLETION DRILL BOOK DRILL KEY PASSAGE DRILL
