Notes to Drill Conductor

- 1. In this printed drill, your words are in BLUE.
- 2. The ESV verses are in **BLACK**. The KJV verses are in **BLUE**. The CSB verses are in **MARROON**.
- 3. I highly recommend utilizing a sheet of paper folded in half to slide down the page to keep your place, but more importantly, as a surface to indicate tally marks as you call on the drill students to help you know how often you have called on a particular student.
- 4. Another consideration is to hole punch the pages of this drill.
